INSURANCE: Contractor shall, at its own cost and expense, prior to commencement of any Services under this Agreement, procure and maintain during the term of this Agreement insurance of the following kinds and amounts, in such form and issued by such insurance companies as shall be satisfactory to the Railroad.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) Workmen's Compensation insurance which fully meets the requirements of any Workmen's Compensation law in force at the place where the Services is to be performed, including the requirements of any Occupational Disease law, and Employers' Liability insurance with limits of not less than the statutory limits. b) Public Liability insurance with limits for bodily injury, including death, of not less than \$1,000,000 for one person and not less than \$3,000,000 for all persons arising out of each occurrence, and limits of not less than \$1,000,000 for damage to or destruction of property, including the loss of use thereof for each occurrence, and not less than \$2,000,000 in the aggregate and \$5,000,000 in excess liability. Such insurance shall include coverage for contractual liability assumed by Contractor under this Agreement, with specific reference made there to. c) Contractor's Protective Liability insurance (if one or more subcontractors are used) with limits of not less than those in (b) above. d) Automobile Liability insurance covering all owned, non-owned and hired vehicles of Contractor engaged in or about the Services with not less than \$1,000,000 combined single limits. <p>Contractor shall also furnish to the Railroad Certificates of Insurance as evidence of compliance with (a), (b), (c) and (d) above and show the Railroad as Additional Insured on the (b) Public Liability (c) Contractor's Protective Liability and (d) Automobile Liability Policies on the certificate.
